DOUBLE DEGREE...

- Double Enrolment consists of the simple possibility of enrolling in two courses simultaneously;
- <u>DOUBLE DEGREE</u> consists of an integrated path that allows the student to obtain a double degree at the end of his/her studies;
- Minor allows students to obtain a 'minor' degree in a course of study other than their own.









DOUBLE DEGREE...

Thanks to agreements with some universities abroad, students enrolled in certain degree, master's and single-cycle courses, can decide to carry out part of their studies at a partner university abroad and obtain a double qualification, one issued by the State University, the other by the foreign university attended or a single title recognized and validated by all the universities involved (joint title).

...This proposal stems from the need to exploit the synergies between degree courses that have affinities, in order to further expand the educational offer; the development of this program is based on similar experiences carried out by Italian universities with foreign universities....









DOUBLE DEGREE [D.M. n. 1059/13]

Specific curriculum within "normal" courses of study: the integrated path is based on the comparison of the learning outcomes envisaged by the curricula activated in each partner location, on the flexible complementarity of the skills acquired and on mobility schemes that compensate for the differences between the different curricula [Guidelines for Degree courses with double certificate].

DOUBLE DEGREE...[Example of Agreement]

AGREEMENT ON A DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAM BETWEEN UNIVERSITY OF TRENTO, DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY AND SOCIAL RESEARCH AND THE UNIVERSITY OF BAMBERG, FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES, ECONOMICS, AND BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The University of Bamberg (henceforth named UNIBA) represented by the President Prof. Dr. Dr. habil. Godehard Ruppert and the University of Trento (henceforth named UniTrento) represented by the Rector Prof. Paolo Collini, PhD, agree:

- (a) to offer a Double Degree Program (henceforth named DDP);
- (b) to strengthen the collaboration and the exchange of scholars and professors of both Departments.

ARTICLE 1 Aim of the agreement

The Double Degree Program (DDP) allows students from both Universities to earn:

- A Master's Degree "Soziologie" (Fakultät Sozial- und Wirtschaftswissenschaften) from UNIBA.
- A Master's Degree in "Sociology and Social Research" (Dipartimento di Sociologia e Ricerca Sociale) from UniTrento.

The number of double degree students to be exchanged is fixed up to maximum of 5 per year for each university. The goal of this program is to exchange on average the same number of students in both directions.









DOUBLE DEGREE...[Example of organization]

4.2 - Organization of the Master's Degree

A coordinating establishment will be regularly designated by the Committee. To start the programme, the IMUS (University of Savoie) is in charge of the coordination.

Students admitted at the European Master in Business Studies will spend a semester in each partner university in the following order:

- 1st year of Master:
 - Semester 1 in Trento (Italy)
 - Semester 2 in Annecy (France)
- 2nd year of Master
 - Semester 3 in Kassel (Germany)
 - o Semester 4 in León (Spain)
- Final Master Thesis is to be written in the 3rd and 4th semester
- An Internship of at least 3 months will take place at the end of the 4th semester

The detailed list of the courses is attached to this agreement (annex A) and is part of it. All courses will be taught in English.

Students will be given the opportunity of learning the language of the country where they spend the semester.
