A 4.2: Update of statutes of partner country HEIs to comply with new regulations on university autonomy

HEI from partner country will present document with proposals on the reform of the governance model from a holistic and functional perspective of their respective institutions.

This include also the updated of the statutes and other regulations that integrate the update of the mechanisms of autonomy.

On the basis of the conclusions of the University Autonomy Scorecard in Kosovo, Albania and Montenegro the HEIs will implement the updated regulations with the approval of rector and university senates.

A 4.3: National/Regional Legal Base update/development to strengthen university autonomy

HEIs in Kosovo, Albania and Montenegro will produce a series of recommendations to the government for the inclusion into the upcoming strategies in education in all three countries.

The consortium will establish the working groups and together with the ministries will work in integration of the recommendation into one document for each country that can further become part of the national/regional strategy on education.
